
Second Annual Pacific Japanese Provisional Conference

THIRD DAY: Sunday, June 8, 1941.

The Conference sermon, "In the Name of Christ, Walk," was preached by the Rev. Y, Yamaka at the Japanese Methodist Church of Alameda. H. Hashimoto and S. Shimada were ordained Elders by Bishop Baker with Dr. F. H. Smith assisting.

The Laymen's Association and the Federation of Ladies' Aids held their annual meetings in the afternoon. At the Youth Rally in the evening, Dr. C. A. Richardson spoke on "Christianizing the City."

ADJOURNMENT - I. Inouye moved that after suitable devotions and the reading of the appointments the Conference stand adjourned. It was accepted. Superintendent Smith read the appointments and the Conference stood adjourned with the benediction of Z. Hirota.
