



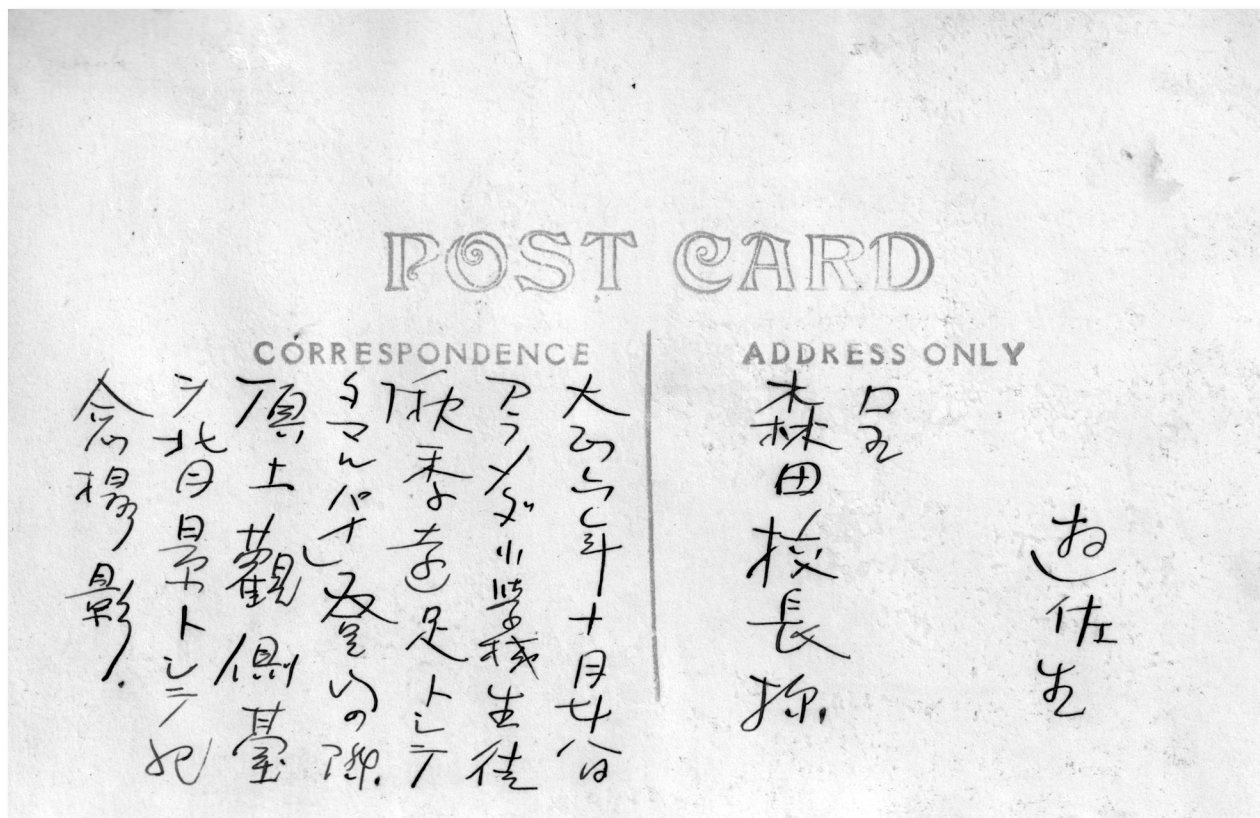

## 1917 Japanese Class Outing to Mt Tamalpais



Translation: To Principal Morita, from Yusa  
Alameda Elementary students climbed Mt.  
Tamalpais, photo taken in front of the Observatory,  
October 28, 1917.

The back of this photo postcard describes an outing taken by students of the California Official Alameda Japanese Elementary School, located at 2256 Pacific Avenue in Alameda, CA.

It also indicates that Takuritsu Morita, seated near the top-center of the group with glasses, was the principal of the school. He was highly regarded as a teacher of the Japanese language to American born Japanese youth and would win awards for his efforts.
