As you are aware the redress measure passed the House on September 17 by a margin of 243 - 141 with 1 voting present and 49 not voting. Following attempts to amend the individual compensation section of the bill, the legislation was passed intact.

At this point it is important to contact those members who voted for the bill thanking them for their support and asking that they continue to support this issue in the future.

Part of the future strategy is to muster a two-thirds vote in the House to override the possibility of a White House veto. Thus it is important that we begin to work on those members who were not supportive (mainly Republicans) by trying to find good contacts who can get to those congressmen.

Senate action on the bill is anticipated this or next week. I am enclosing a breakdown of HR442 vote for the Midwest.
