Thank you for your letter regarding S. 1647, the Commission for Wartime Relocation and Internment of Civilians Act. I am glad to have the benefit of your views.


As you know, this legislation establishes a Commission to gather facts to determine whether any wrong was committed against those American citizens and permanent resident aliens affected by Executive Order 9066.

Senator Inouye introduced this measure on August 8. It is currently pending before the Senate Governmental Affairs Committee. On September 28, Rep. Wright introduced an identical bill on the House side, which is awaiting action before the House Judiciary Committee.

Please be assured I will give your concerns careful consideration if and when this legislation comes to the floor of the Senate for a vote.
