This is to acknowledge and thank you for your letter of October 17 regarding your request that I cosponsor H.R. 5499, the Commission on Wartime Relocation and Internment of Civilians Act.

As you may know, H.R. 5499 is presently pending before the Subcommittee on Administrative Law of the House Judiciary Committee with no action scheduled at this time. I appreciate learning of your interest in this matter and can understand your legitimate concern with the historical significance of this bill. While it has been my general policy in the House to limit my sponsorship and cosponsorship of legislation to areas which fall under my purview as Chairman of the House Foreign Affairs Committee, nevertheless, in response to your request I intend to cosponsor H.R. 5499.
