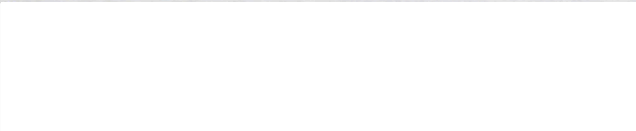

Thank you for your letter of September 20. I have informed Norman Mineta that I would act as cosponsor of the bill that he and Congressman Wright were filing. However, I should like to make the point again that I made in our conference in my office that I favor redress and that I consider the Commission bill as a first step in achieving that goal. One has only to look at the first paragraph of your letter to recognize the justice of making redress for an unwarranted wrong which never received proper recognition.
