I was so glad to learn of your involvement in the reparations campaign. At last we can be sure that something will happen!

In response to your request on reparations surveys in the Midwest, I am sending you the information from the one the MDC conducted in the summer of 1975, under the leadership of Bill Doi. Basically, he sent a copy of the questionnaire to each chapter who were supposed to reproduce it and distribute it to their members. With a great deal of follow-up on his part, eventually every chapter except Cleveland responded. (Incidentally, Cleveland is presently completing a reparations survey of their own.)

Bill sent me the tabulated results from the MDC survey which I am forwarding to you, along with the additional comments made by individuals on the bottom of their questionnaires. The P.C. article of October 10, 1975 about the survey was not quite complete, since additional results were subsequently received.
