As you are aware, the National JACL has undertaken the Redress issue as a major priority. We have achieved much success in enlisting support among the members of the United States Senate and House of Representatives. To date, 22 Senators have co-sponsored S. 1647 and 137 Congressmen have co-sponsored HR 5499.

Hearings have been held on the Senate side and we anticipate full Senate action shortly. On the House side, HR 5499 still awaits hearings in the Judiciary Subcommittee on Administrative Law and Governmental Relations.


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I have enclosed Congressman Porter's address as well as a sample letter and a copy of the bill.
