
Dear Jackie:

Lillian Kimura asked that I forward the enclosed information pertaining to legislation currently pending in Congress which would provide for compensation for those individuals who were removed from the West Coast and interned in detention camps during World War II. As you may be aware, the House bill is entitled "The Civil Liberties Act of 1985" and is numbered HR 442. The Senate bill is numbered S. 1053.

Our present goal is to convince the various congressmen and senators to cosponsor the respective pieces of legislation. Currently Hr 442 has 111 cosponsors while S. 1053 has 27 cosponsors.

We would appreciate any help you may offer in securing the support of your congressman, George Darden, and the two senators, Sam Nunn and Mack Mattingly.
