RESOLUTION GUIDELINES

1. Resolutions must be received at ONE Headquarters, 5249 N. Kenmore by Friday, March 29, 1985, by 5 pm.
2. Resolutions will be screened by the Convention Platform Committee.
3. Resolutions can be submitted by current delegate organizations and constituency groups.
4. All resolutions must be in conformance with overall ONE policy and goals:

"ONE is committed to maintain the diverse ethnic nature of the ONE communities, to effectively promote the dignity, trust, & unity among all our people, and to empower the community to work towards a shared vision of the ONE community."

5. Resolutions must promote issues relating specifically to the residents and groups of the ONE Community.
6. Priority will be given to the resolutions which focus on community wide issues.
7. Statement of the problem (the "Whereas" sections) that give rise to the need for the resolution should be stated specifically and in logical order.
8. The resolution (the "Therefore" section) which "authorizes and directs" action should be stated generally, focusing on the goals to be achieved; keeping in mind that implementation rests with the work of ONE.
9. Resolutions submitted must have:
 - name of group or organization (if submitted by group)
 - date passed
 - submitted by - a) group as whole
b) committee
c) board
d) individuals
 - if submitted by individuals (optional)

10. The Convention Platform Committee will have final authority to determine the appropriateness of a resolution.
