

100th Battalion Combat Timeline

September 2, 1943 100th arrives Oran, North Africa, assigned to 133rd Infantry Regiment, 34th Division

NAPLES – FOGGIA

September 22, 1943 100th lands at Salerno
September 29, 1943 100th 1st battle at Castelvetere – 1st KIA
October 1, 1943 100th battle at Benevento
October 18, 1943 1st Voltumo River Crossing
October 30, 1943 2nd Voltumo River Crossing
November 3, 1943 3rd Voltumo River Crossing
December 15, 1943 100th E&F Companies inactivated and merged into C company
December ??, 1943 Battle of Coli (mostly E,F, and A Co)
January 15, 1944 100th San Michele Battle
January 25, 1944 100th cross Rapido River at Cassino
February 8, 1944 100th attack Castle Hill at Cassino
February 15, 1944 Cassino Abbey bombed by US Army Air Force
February ??, 1944 1st replacements arrive from 442nd RCT
March 26, 1944 100th goes to Anzio by Landing Ship Tanks
Replacements arrive in Naples & Anzio

May 16, 1944 Colonel Kim and Pvt Akahoshi capture Germans

ROME-ARNO

June 4, 1944 100th captures key mountain pass at Lunuvio after bitter battle
June 5, 1944 100th enters Rome
June 11, 1944 100th at Civitavecchia and joins 442nd
June 26, 1944 100th as part of 442nd enters battle at Suvereto and take Belvedere and Sassetta
July 7, 1944 Battle for Hill 140 starts

July 18, 1944 100th occupies Leghorn. Leghorn captured by 91st Infantry Division

September 1, 1944 100th crosses Arno River just east of Pisa. Enter Pisa from north to visit Church and Tower

September 10, 1944 100th and 442nd leaves Italy from Naples for Marseille, France

RHINELAND/VOSGES FOREST CAMPAIGN

September 29-
October 9, 1944 100th arrives in Marseille, trucked to Vosges Mountains, joins 36th Division

October 15-18, 1944 100th battle for Hill A near Bruyeres, Bruyeres liberated

October 19, 1944 100th battle for Hill C

October 22, 1944 100th battle for Biffontaine

October 27-30, 1944 100th participate in battle for Lost Battalion

CHAMPAIGN CAMPAIGN

November 28, 1944 100th sent to Menton – rest and time for reorganization and training. Controlled French Riviera from Monte Carlos to Italian border

NORTHERN APPENINES

March 20, 1945 442nd and 100th arrives in Leghorn, Italy

PO VALLEY / GOTHIC LINE

March 28, 1945 100th and 442nd assigned to 92nd Division at Lucca, Italy

April 5, 1945 100th attacks Gothic Line, breakout in 32 minutes. Sadao Munemori KIA

April 6, 1945 Mountain Cerreta/Hill 702

April 10-27, 1945 100th and 442nd chase Germans up the Italian Coast, until Genoa and Busalla

May 2, 1945 War in Italy ends

May 8, 1945 Germany surrenders

OCCUPATION

May 31, 1945 100th and 442nd stationed at Ghedi Airport. First soldier rotated stateside
