The truth hurts but it is needed to tell the young Japanese-Americans the truth about the camps. I'm happy that people like you and Eji speak your minds and not act like Japanese.

I was hoping to meet you in Los Angeles on Feb. 21. I thought that they might pay for your expenses and honor you for your support. I hope that it becomes a reality. I understand that things are costing them and that they are busy trying to organize. Believe me, trying to organize a group of resisters is almost impossible. Just a handful of us resisters in our area cooperated and the wives sure helped to create the pot luck dinner. Takes a lot of work. My brother is now very ill and the doctor says that he is very weak. He was a WWII veteran but kept a low profile. He was not a member of the 442 group. Please to wait and take care.
