## 400 Japs Go To Tule Lake

Volunteers En Route to Harvest Crops

Nearly 400 Japanese volunteers are en route to Tule Lake Relocation Center to harvest crops which disloyal Japs there refuse to touch, the War Relocation Authority (WRA) said yesterday. They will arrive Monday.

"We do not expect their arrival to cause trouble because they will be quartered on the farm grounds, away from the strikers," said C. E. Zimmer, assistant director of the center.

Tule Lake is the center set aside for disloyal Japs. They struck earlier this week, declaring they were prisoners of war who could not be compelled to work except to keep their quarters clean.

WRA officials said there has been no violence and none is expected.
