

Last Will and Testament

We prepared this document in case that an expected event happens and we both die simultaneously. If either of us survives, the survivor's will shall be respected and this document be revised accordingly.

Terms

- (1) The property where we reside currently (2176 Ave. 38 Los Angeles, California) will be given to Fumio and Yoneko Takano. However, if Fumio dies and his widow, Yoneko, decides to remarry, the property shall be transferred to their son, Kazuo Robert Takano, prior to her remarriage.
- (2) All assets attached to the property, including household furniture and furnishings, will be given to Fumio and Yoneko Takano.
- (3) Fumio Takano can make a decision on our car.
- (4) All savings are deposited in Bank of America Highland Park Branch and Sumitomo Bank. It is impossible to estimate how much the savings will remain when we die. In any case, after paying our funeral expenses, the remaining savings should be shared among the following beneficiaries:

Akiko Nakajima, first daughter
Shoji Takano, second son
Mariko Hirashima, second daughter
Kiyoshi Takano, third son
Hideo Takano, fourth son

The savings should be divided equally among them.

- (5) Fumio Takano should not take our savings. Since he inherits the real property, it is not fair for others if he receives the savings additionally.
- (6) If any of our family does not wish to inherit Japanese language books, donate them to appropriate places.
