General Meeting

Meeting called to order by Pres. Ogi

Communications read:

1 - Letter of thank from Mr. Wm. Muscutt for the cigarettes sent to him as appreciation for the use of his truck for the New Years Dance

2 - Letters regarding the Anti-Alien Fishing Bills from Mr. Walter Sankamoto.
