

Executive Meeting

July 10, 1940

The meeting was called to order by President James Sabata.

Report on the 4th of July Parade was given. The approximate cost of the parade was about \$8.00 but few bills were yet outstanding.

Sachi Higuchi reported \$103.00 in the treasury.

President Sabata announced the 4th of July phonograph dance was called off due to the lack of time for preparations. He asked that, hereafter, more time and consideration be given our activities before we sponsor them. A letter of thanks asked to be sent to Dorney's for the use of their P. A. system.

Fusako Kodani announced the Women's Auxiliary had met and the girls would prepare the box lunches for the auction. It was recommended the sale for the lunches would start at 15¢ for the small boxes and 20¢ for the large boxes.

The Salinas Skut Club is sponsoring a talent show July 19th. The Chapter choir is to participate.

Due to the fact that on July 19th the girls of the choir will participate in the Skut Club talent show, the monthly dance class, which falls on the same date, will be postponed.

President Sabata announced Yoshio Sabata and Hoshito Miyamoto were appointed co-chairmen of the Drawing to carry on the work started by former chairman Hal Higashi.

The Executive Board recommends we sponsor a benefit movie in August.

The Board recommends to the general assembly the purchase of the mimeograph at the cost of \$115.00. Announced the Japanese Association will appropriate \$25.00 toward the buying of the mimeograph.

Announced that Shizue Kawada had donated a ping pong set and table for the J.A.C.L. room. As the duties of the 1st vice-president - Teruo Esaki asked to be administrator of the club room and to work out a recreation program.

It was suggested a look-out committee be formed to encourage more members to come out to the meetings.

Discussion on electing an editor for the "Trade Wind" was tabled till a later date. Meanwhile the next edition of the "Trade Wind" will be published and mailed to the members on August 1st.

Letters from Senator Tickle and San Francisco District Council were read.

The meeting adjourned.
