Announced the Womens Auxiliary has been sewing for the Red Cross.

George Nakaji gave reports on Pacific Citizens, special assessments etc. from the San Francisco District Council meeting. He announced that our request for \$100.00 for our convention fund had been granted. The delegates to the meeting were Hideto Takeyawa, Oyster Miyamoto and George Nakaji.

August 15 and 16 the dates set for the Japanese Benefit Show. The admission price <sup>for</sup> will be \$50 for members with membership cards.

Oyster Miyamoto gave a report on the Drawing to be held on October 12th. 5,000 tickets has been printed. Announced the First prize to be a Longines wrist watch - other prizes will be donations from local merchants.
