

Feb. 6, 1941

General Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President James Tabata.

The minutes were read and approved.

Teruo Esaki stated that for the coming convention a lot of mail will be transacted by the Chapter and asked that a post office box be secured for the Club.

Yoshitazu Higashi stated that a full report on the New Years Dance could not be given because of outstanding bills. Report tabled until next meeting.

A report on the Infantile Paralysis fund given. The proceeds of the Minato basketball game and skating party was \$10.05. The march of Dimes drive by the Womens Auxiliary \$10.00. Tad Marumoto and Henry Yamate and their committee were thanked for their fine work on the skating party.

The President announced a successful Inaugural Dinner was held at Asilomar. The Chapter had 13 city and Japanese Association officials as its guest.

President Tabata asked all members pay up their membership dues. He stated that special rates and privileges will be given on club activities to only those holding membership cards. Only members in good standing will be entitled to membership cards. Good standing at this instance requires payments of all delinquent 1940 dues and January 1941 dues. Sachi Higuchi showed a chart which will be displayed on the bulletin board with a record of each months standing of all members.

President Tabata asked for suggestions for the annual membership drive. Kaz Oka suggested a calendar of the whole years activities be map out and be presented to prospective members. Fusako Kodani move we hold the annual membership drive starting Feb. 15 and ending Mar. 15th. Seconded by Hideto Takigawa. Motion Carried. Seizo Kodani appointed Chair man of the membership drive.

President Tabata asked members to make any suggestions or bring up and new business which they may have during the meeting.

Harry Menda suggested the Chapter get the cooperation of the Japanese Association and sponsor and outing or picnic for the Japanese Community. Harry Menda appointed to investigate the advisability of such an outing or picnic.

Kaz Oka suggested the chapter help the first generation by holding classes or assist in some way the filing of the Income Taxes. Roy Hattori and Takashi Sasaki appointed to investigate whether it is necessary that the chapter assist on the Income Tax.

Announced the N.C.D.C. meeting in Cudkern on Feb. 16th. Any one wishing to go get in touch with the President.

Harry Higashi asked that the Chapter get the \$100.00 for the Convention which was promised us by the N.C.D.C.

Mamie Honda announced the women's auxiliary will be held Feb. 24 at Sachi Higuchi.

The President asked for volunteers to sell J.A.C.L. pins. Those interested see the Treasurer or President.
