Kaz Oka moved we devise ways of acquiring the building located on 424 Adams St. Monterey. George Nakaji seconded. Motion Carried. A committee of Hal Higashi, James Sabata, Teruo Esaki and Seizo Kodani asked to contact proper authorities immediately.

Announced the National Headquarters is in need of money to carry on the work of the emergency.

Discussion on the Clubroom project. It was suggested we pay \$100 for the lumber right away.

Recommended we send \$50 toward the emergency fund and tell them we are planning ways to raise money.

Decided to send \$65 for the National Secretary

fund immediately.

The J.A.C.L. will conduct a Red Cross fund campaign among the fishermen.

The Executive Board and this special committee will take the liberty, when necessary to enforce these projects without the consent of the general assembly.

Suggested we send New Year's Greetings and Thank you letters to friends who have helped us.

The meeting adjourned.
