A. Copy of letter to Topaz Community Council from the Canal Community Council in regards to the closing of schools was received.

B. Copy of letter to Masaru Nishihara, chairman of All-Center Conference from Mr. Willon S. Myer in regards to the 21 recommendations of the All-Center Conference. This will be printed in both English and Japanese.

Mr. S. Fujimoto reported that after conferring with Mr. Guy Robertson in regards to the Depot pass, informed the Council that it was impossible for the WRA to change the ruling since it was an Army order. Those on the white list are permitted to go out of the gate with a depot pass but others can not obtain the passes.

M. Tsunokai gave a report on the C. A. meeting.

After a lengthy discussion, Mr. S. Donao made a motion seconded by G. Endo that contributions from each block shall be asked and paid to the C. A. This is the loan made by C. A. to the Council and Study Committee for the traveling expenses of the delegates to the all-center Conference.

S. Fujimoto explained that the picnic was not under the sole sponsorship of the Council but jointly with the C. A., C. E., Block Managers and the Council.
