The meeting was called to order by M. Hayashida, Chairman.

ROLL CALL

Absentee: M. Tsunokai (Block 20)
Attended: Mr. Kobayashi (25 proxy)

The minutes of April 13th were approved as read.

COMMUNICATION REVIEWED:

A. A letter was received from Minidoka Community Council in regards to exchanging of menus of mess halls.

F. Inosaita stated that he interviewed the Community Enterprise members on taxes.

G. Nakaki informed the Council that the 21 recommendations will be in the Sentinel this Saturday. M. Hayashida and S. Kodama will help the Japanese Section in translating the recommendations.

Mr. Hatchimonji tendered his resignation due to his intention to soon relocate.

The Council was informed that visitors to the center will be charged \$8.40 (two weeks) for subsistence; but those accomplishing relocation of center residents will have their money refunded.

All blocks were asked to donate \$35 for the expenses of delegates to Salt Lake. Block 7 will pay \$12.

The Evacuee Relocation Planning Board (Kyojusha Saitenju Sodansho) was chosen as the name for the organization formerly constituted as the Relocation Planning Commission. It will be formed with one committee man appointed from each block. A chairman and a secretary will be elected, from the above body. The committeeman will be selected at the regular block meeting which will be held April 30th.

Advice in regards to receiving of the Relocation Cash Grant was reported by K. Hatchimonji.

A motion was made to establish an expediting committee on matters in connection with the relocation center. It will become active as soon as a letter from Mr. Dillon S. Myer in regards to the petition sent by the All-Center Conference is announced to the center residents.

A motion was made by Z. Saito seconded by M. Hoshizaki to send representatives from the Council to the Liquidation Study Committee of D.C. This was unanimously passed.

The meeting adjourned 11:40 a.m.
