COMMITTEE REPORTS

Food

Due to the resignation of H. Tonooka, who is relocating soon, Shinji Fujimoto was appointed to succeed Mr. Tonooka to serve on the Food Committee.

Health and Sanitation

T. Shoguchi of the Health and Sanitation Committee reported that there has been an increase in the number of patients in need of hospitalization. Since Wards 5 and 8 have been closed due to the lack of nurses aides, this work is a hardship on everyone. Many of the former nurses aides and girls who are in positions to serve in the hospital have returned from seasonal work outside the center; therefore, it was recommended that a memorandum be sent to M. O. Anderson, Assistant Project Director, suggesting that Ward 5 and 8 be reopened.

Welfare

S. Donao of the Welfare Committee suggested that the dark areas, especially around the High School, be provided with electric lights for the safety of pedestrians. It was recommended also that the deep foundation in Block 26 be fenced off to prevent accidents. The Welfare Committee will confer with Mr. Anderson regarding the matter.

NEW BUSINESS

Sentinel Space Purchased

It was agreed that "Sentinel" advertising space for Christmas and New Year greetings be purchased for \$3.00 out of the Council fund.

Memorial Service Speaker

M. Hayashida was selected to offer Council condolences at the Community Memorial Service to be held at the High School Auditorium on December 9, 2:00 p.m.
