The meeting was called to order by Mr. Hayashida, chairman.

ROLL CALL:

Present: Mr. Joe Carroll, Relocation Officer, and Mr. M. O. Anderson,
Assistant Project Director.
Absentee: Block 1 and Block 25.

COMMUNICATION:

Memorandum from Mr. Wiseman concerning the closing of Mess Hall 2-27 on July 31 was received.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

It was reported by Mr. Kawano that the letter sent by the All Center Conference Headquarter has been answered on July 24, 1945.

The matter of using poultry house ceiling lumber for crating household furnitures at the warehouse will be taken up by the Sanitation Committee.

Mr. Joe Carroll and Mr. M. O. Anderson attended the meeting to explain the revised procedure for handling loading, traffic, and crowds for departing special cars. Mr. Carroll explained the following reasons for the change: (1) for the convenience of those relocating, (2) for the safety of the people, especially children, and (3) to assist the railway company.

Mr. Carroll stated that an interview must be made with all residents in the Center in order to work out the program of transportation by September 1. He stated that interviews with the people in the Center will not be a Relocation Planning interview. The interview will be taken from block to block beginning August 1. Mr. Carroll stated that the following questions will be asked:

1. Have you any relocation plans? (Answer yes or no)
2. If answer is yes, the location.
3. Approximate date of departure.
4. Have you contacted either the relocation or the welfare section for Relocation Planning? If yes, the approximate date of the last contact.
5. Any remarks?

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:50 a.m.
