A. Letter from All Center Conference Headquarter, Topaz, Utah regarding All Center Conference Meeting.

COMMITTEE REPORT:

Mr. Nakaki reported on the suggestion made by the Council regarding delivery of boxes before October 15. He stated that according to Mr. Burnett, Evacuee Property Officer, tentative plans for delivery of packing cases for relocation purposes is to begin October 1. After this date, if the head of the family will go to Mr. Burnett and sign for boxes, he will get them regardless of the date of departure.

The Food Committee was asked to investigate the present situation in the Mess Halls.

Discussion indicated that the Community Enterprise Canteens should continue its services until such time the WRA takes over. According to the present schedule the Enterprise Canteens will be closed on August 18 and will not open again until September 1. This will be inconvenient for Center residents, therefore, the Community Enterprise Block Representatives are being asked to do something about it.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:15 a.m.
