The meeting was called to order by Mr. Kawano, Chairman.

ROLL CALL:

Present: Mr. Guy Robertson, Mr. M. O. Anderson, and Mr. Joe Carroll.  
Absentee: Block 8.

COMMUNICATION:

A letter of resignation from Mr. Shigekichi Isobe, Block 14 Councilman  
was read.

DISCUSSIONS:

Mr. Guy Robertson, Mr. M. O. Anderson, and Mr. Joe Carroll were present  
to explain the orderly movement of closing the center. It was stated that this  
movement is being done so as not to congest transportation during the last few  
weeks before the center closes. Mr. Robertson stated that every person scheduled  
for departure will have temporary or permanent housing. It was also stated by  
Mr. Robertson that WRA will do everything possible to assist each family with a  
minimum of inconvenience or trouble.

Mr. Anderson discussed the problem of block organization during the last  
few weeks before the center closes. It was stated that it is the desire of the  
Administration to keep the block offices open and maintain a minimum block  
organization as long as possible but block personnel are not being asked to delay  
relocation for this reason.

After a discussion the meeting was adjourned at 11:10 a.m.
