A. Copy of a petition sent to Mr. Dillon S. Myer from the Topaz Community Council.

DISCUSSION:

Mr. Main, Procurement and Supply Officer, was asked to attend the meeting to explain the coal situation. It was stated that it was due to shortage of workers. The Council suggested that coal be ordered in large quantity at one time to replenish the present coal shortage. If such quantity of coal is obtained, the Council agreed to secure volunteers to help unload and deliver coal to the blocks to alleviate the present coal shortage.
