The Manzanar Work Corps, with its Fair Practice Committee and the various committees, has for its broad program the following purposes:

- (1) Defend and uphold fair employment practice.
- (2) Undertake a center-wide educational campaign for cooperative effort.
- (3) Establish means for vocational counseling and guidance for evacuees.
- (4) Provide methods for training of workers for post-war employment.
- (5) Assist in providing relocation and furlough for workers.
- (6) Provide for successful rehabilitation of evacuees.
