GOING TO BE ANY JOBS OPENED
TO THE JAPANESE AGAIN? IN
MY OPINION I THINK THAT FARM-
ING IS GOING TO BE THE BEST
JOB FOR THE JAPANESE PEOPLE. AFTER
THIS WAR, I HAVE RECEIVED
LETTER FROM FRIEND WHO SAY
THAT IT IS HARD TO GET FRESH
FOOD. THIS IS BECAUSE EVERYONE

JOBS AND GONE TO NATIONAL DEFENCE
