I wonder where you are now? Faces are changing so rapidly around here I can't keep up with them anymore. Today Ann Deane has left for the Separation Club. She was my only original company member. Brack, Fuzzy, Ohie, Madie, Portwood, Nan Mary that and many others have disappeared.

On the other hand Jimmy Ford came back to me and just made 15. We are all promotion happy here. 54 for October and 27 for November - many good ones, too!

The period on married women is just about decimating 1111 and making quite a gap here. All we do is type and sign discharges. Other than that no real news except that Sgt + Mrs Cheney are our neighbors in one of the brick quarters. Have had no complaints from her yet. She and Daisy are staying in the service as long as they can.

Miss Bee is a civilian now also

We are getting some typical Arctic weather today and the girls who have never seen snow before think its terrific. Me - I am just resigned. Do you remember Lt. O'Brien. She wrote me from Manila that she was on her way home. So we are planning a royal celebration for her when she comes. We have the plans all laid.
