Dear Mr. Okine:

Due to the liquidation of the War Relocation Authority, please be advised that the Hawthorne Project, which is located at 12220 South Aviation Blvd., Hawthorne, California, will close not later than April 30, 1946. All tenants are urged to secure other housing at the earliest possible date.

War Relocation Authority personnel will be available at the project daily to advise residents in making the necessary arrangements for housing. These personnel will have on file job offers which provide housing. We suggest that if you do not have alternate housing that you contact these personnel immediately so they may assist you.

Most of the trailers on this site are required for a new housing project which is being constructed. If you are occupying a trailer you will probably be required to vacate by April 4 or within a few days thereafter. At the time your trailer is removed, if there are vacant barrack apartments, you will be permitted to reside there, but not beyond April 30. However, there is no absolute assurance there will be such vacancies and you should make every effort to locate your own housing by April 4.

Veterans' or Service connected families should see the FPFA housing manager immediately about alternate arrangements. Persons requiring domiciliary or special medical care should contact the project representative of the Bureau of Public Assistance of Los Angeles County.
