ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF CLASS E ALLOTMENT-OF-PAY

1. This is to inform you that a class E allotment-of-pay, as shown on the reverse side of this form, has been filed in your favor by the serviceman whose name and Army serial number are shown.
2. The Office of Dependency Benefits will forward checks to you as they become due shortly AFTER the end of the month in which they are deducted from the serviceman's pay. Thus, an allotment-of-pay commencing the first of June is deducted from the serviceman's pay at the end of June and is payable to the allottee at the beginning of July.
3. If you change your address notify the Office of Dependency Benefits of your new address as far in advance as possible. Also give written notification to your local postmaster, on the form provided by the Post Office, of any change of address in order that he may forward your check to the new address. Sign your name on the Post Office form exactly as it appears on your check. Failure to do this may result in a delayed delivery of your check.
4. Correspondence concerning this allotment-of-pay should not be necessary. If it is essential, however, to make an inquiry in connection with this allotment-of-pay, the name of the allotter, his ARMY SERIAL NUMBER, and the name of the allottee must be given. As you will notice, the allotter's Army serial number is shown on the reverse side.
