

Block Managers, Chairmen Offer Cooperation

Project Director Guy Robertson indicated today he had received replies from both block managers and block chairmen regarding his memorandum last week placing responsibility for the voluntary enlistment record in their laps. Both groups, Robertson said, expressed their desire to cooperate with the administration in every way to push the program to a successful conclusion.

"If you believe there is some way to bring about better results even at this eleventh hour, we will be more than pleased to do our best," the block chairmen wrote. "We regret far more than the administration the unsatisfactory result of the registration, for we realize the full implication of this result which may have direct bearing on our future welfare."

At the same time Lieut. Ray McDaniel, chief of the Army registration team, announced that he had received permission from the War Department to stay until Thursday, March 11, to accept further enlistments. Lieut. McDaniel and his staff will be at the administration recreation hall, barrack 11, Wednesday and Thursday to register volunteers and answer questions regarding the Army. Dillon S. Myer announced in Washington that Minidoka, Idaho had 300 volunteers registered.
