

### Jobs Available for Nisei Women in Net Industry

Employment is now available to young nisei women in net manufacturing industry which is classified as a 100 per cent war industry, Joe Carroll, employment chief, announced today. The company, which manufactures all types of nets including fishing and seining nets for the Army, is offering employment to female American citizens between ages 18-35. Single persons are preferred and because work is mostly of standing nature, sound physical condition is necessary as well as good eyesight and nimbleness and dexterity of the hands.

Beginning wages are 45 cents per hour and all employees will participate in a bonus schedule which will net them \$9 per week extra. Periodical increases will also be granted.
