A few Do's and Don'ts for you to always remember.

The Don'ts

Don't forget to turn off switch and pull the electric cord when through using your electric appliances.

Don't let an accumulation of combustible materials in your closet or corners of your home, be neat and tidy around your living quarters, as it is the right road to good health.

Don't throw any lighted matches or burning cigarettes around carelessly, see that they are entirely out before discarding, as carelessness is one of the main causes of fires.

Do be on the look-out at all times for fires, as small fires can become large fires if they are not put out in their infancy or first stages.

Do remember that when fires occur that they can cause a large amount of damage to you and probably your loved ones. The U.S. Government has spent enormous amount of money for apparatus, equipment and maintenance for your safe keeping. Let's do our part in maintaining this Center from any fires. It is better to have and hold, than to lose. Keep the home fires burning and not the Property. Always remember the three main causes for fires are Carelessness, Electricity and Spontaneous Combustion.

○しない事

(一)電氣用器具を使つて濟み次第スイッチを切つて電氣の紐を引き抜く事を忘れない事。

(一)クロセツトの中や部屋の際に火の付き易い品を投げ棄て、直かぬ事。常に室内を整理して清潔に保つ事は衛生上にも善い。

(一)火の付いたマツチ巻煙草は火が全く消えるまで打棄てぬ事。不注意は火事になる一大原因。

○すべき事

(一)目を四方に配つて常に火に注意する事。大事に至らざる前に消し止むる様心懸けねばならぬ。

(一)火事は自分や家族や隣人にまでも大損害を與へる事を記憶せよ。政府は大金を拂つて吾等の爲にあらゆる設備を整へた。吾等は火災から自己の利益を守らなければならぬ。竈は燃やせ、住家は燃やすな。

不注意、漏電、自然發火が多く出火の原因となる。

(一)出火の際は氣を落ち付けて慌てずに消防部に知らせる事。

(一)大切な持ち物は失はない様に、そして戦時公債を買ふ様に、各自義務を果してポンドを多く買ひませう。
