Religion in one form or another is an important part of the lives of the wast majority of people.

Hence early in camp life buildings were set aside for this purpose. One for the Christians and one for the Shinto and Buddist faith.

The Protestant ministers of Crystal City rotated a month at a time and services were held each Sunday evening. For the German Lutherans a minister came down twice a month from San Antonio.

There was a Catholic priest among the German internees, so those of the Catholic faith were taken care of by him.

Those of the Shinto and Buddist faith had many priests among their group and also held their services regularly.
