

New Postal Rates Effective Sunday

New postal rates which will become effective on Sunday, March 26, are as follows: airmail within states, 8 cents per oz.; mail to Cody, 3 cents; money order fees to begin at 10 cents instead of 6 cents; registry fees to begin at 20 cents instead of 15 cents; insurance and COD charges to be doubled.

Remaining at old rates are the following: postal cards, 1 cent; letters within center, 1 cent; airmail to soldiers, 6 cents per half ounce overseas; airmail for soldiers, 6 cents per full ounce in states; airmail to Hawaii 20 cents per half ounce; 3 cents letter rate; parcels under 8 ounces and third class matter (which includes the Sentinel).

Red Cross Medicines Distributed to Block Offices

The health and sanitation committee of the community council announced that the medicines received from the Japanese Red Cross were distributed Tuesday to the block managers' office.

The shipment, which included 199 bottles of takadiastase (a relief for indigestion), 16 cartons of isan (a neutralizer for gastric acidity), and 102 bottles of mercurochrome, was divided equally among 20 blocks. The quota for each block will be kept at the office of the block manager to be used whenever residents need the medicine.

This method is being employed since the shipment was not ample enough to be distributed to individual apartments.
