

## PROPOSED PLAN FOR AGRICULTURAL RESETTLERS

### Location

- I Select sites where church groups, community at large and civic groups are favorably receptive to the Japanese
  - A. Preferably in localities where land to be used are owned by Insurance companies, Federal Gov't, or other holding companies; where they are easily obtainable through leasing or renting.
  - B. In localities where the Japanese will not be a competitive factor to the already existing farms. Possibly by raising new crops; such as truck crops in communities with majority of farmers in staples and livestock.

### Method of Operation

- I Obtain enough land for group of farmers--5 to 10 families and establish co-operative farming unit where equipments, buying and selling facilities could be shared.
  - A. Families to be hand picked so their background, interests, and experiences will be somewhat similar, thus assuring maximum chances of harmonious living and productivity.

### Financing

(Because many evacuees have not the funds available for the initial outlay of capital, the following proposal is presented:)

- I Investigate possibilities for a loan through FSA or other Gov't agency.
- II Failing in this as an alternative plan--establishment of credit unions with subscription among the interested church groups.
