7. The Health Program

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COMMITTEE:

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The Committee agreed that it would be unwise to give specific recommendations for Project School Health Programs because of the variation among the Centers in the type and amount of medical services made available for the schools.

The Committee further recognizes that the School Health Program will be directly affected by decreases in the Project Medical personnel.

It makes the following recommendations:

1. When a center makes transfers of evacuees to another Project, it is recommended that the Medical Social Worker (or some other person delegated by the hospital) survey the medical records of all departing school children and prepare a report of all health deviates for the use of the Education Section at the center of destination.
2. The Committee recommends that Superintendents circulate any health education bulletins, units of work, or curriculum suggestions they have prepared to the other Centers. The Committee feels that there is a need for some directed attention to organized health education in the school curriculum.
3. It is recommended that those Centers which have a Supervisor of Health and Physical Education prepare a documentary report on the coordinated health program operating between the Education and Medical Sections.
