CONSERVATION OF NATURAL RESOURCES

WHERE AS--

BE IT RESOLVED--

Conservation of water is necessary
for national use

1. that rental, rather than sale
of public water rights be in effect
2. soil erosion be controlled
3. reforestation is used
4. dikes and dams on streams be
controlled
5. we save underground water
6. regional planning for water
conservation through the develop-
ment of co-ordinated power, irri-
gation, and domestic water supply
and general water use plans be
under control.

Conservation of soil is necessary
for national use

1. Necessary cooperation in the
part of all farmers, as well as
state-wide, regional, and nation-
wide cooperation, to establish
soil control is needed.

Conservation of forestry is neces-
sary for national use

1. We follow the program for re-
forestation by both the Federal
and state governments, and also
by individual farmers and land-
owners.

Conservation of minerals is neces-
sary for national use

1. We abandon beehive coking
2. We improve mining methods
3. We utilize lower grades of
ore.
4. We use efficient amount of
all by-products.
5. We rework salvagable minerals

Conservation of Wild Life is neces-
sary for national use

1. Sportsmen and nature lovers
have an organization to protect
wild life.
2. The governments--Federal,
state, and local take important
steps through restocking of game
refuges, hunting laws, and protec-
tion for wild flowers, birds, and
animals.

LABOR vs CAPITAL

WHEREAS--

The wage earner's right to organize and bargain collectively and his struggle upward to fight the exploitation of Capital to overcome the great difference between the two classes must be recognized.

The basic needs of business and Labor must be understood.

The present relations between Labor and Capital must be improved, and the government's position clarified, for the benefit of all three parties concerned and for the entire nation and its people in this war.
