ADOPT RESOLUTION TO SEND GIFTS TO JAPANESE SOLDIERS HELD BY U S GIFT DRIVE EXPECTED IN NEAR FUTURE

A resolution was drawn and unagimously accepted on September 11 to send gifts to some 750 Japanese prisoners now held in the various war prisoner camps in the United States, disclosed the Block Managers' Headquarter.

Ward chairmen were appointed to take full charge of negotiations to carry out this resolution and contacts are already being made with authorities in Washington, D.C., and with the Spanish Consul.

A recent official communication received from the Spanish Consul confirmed that prisoners of war might be allowed individually to receive parcels containing food and other articles. This is according to Article 37 of Geneva Treaty.

A drive to collect gifts is expected to start in the near future.

MEXICANS WANT TO INTERN JAPANESE

MAZATLAND, Mexico--The local Mexican newspaper, El Alachan, published recently a demand that authorities of this state place all local Japanese in concentration camps.

The paper hinted broadly that the Japanese are acting as spies. It was also reported that in certain other Mexican states some Japanese have been interned.

MYER REPORTS 45 CENTER NISEI KILLED IN ITALY ; TULE CASUALTIES GIVEN

Forty five American soldiers of Japanese ancestry with next of kin living in relocation centers have been killed in action in Italy, Dillon Myer, national director of the WRA, reported on September 7 to Secretary of Interior Ickes.

Myer said that other casualty telegrams received in the centers have told of 92 wounded and two missing.

The men, most of whom were volunteers from the relocation centers in 1943 for the Japanese American combat team, were evacuated with their families in 1942 from the three Pacific Coast states.

It is presumed that the 45 reported killed are part of a total of 120 Japanese Americans previously reported killed in action with the 442nd Regimental Combat Team since the unit entered the front lines late in June.

The following soldiers with next of kin residing in Tule Lake Center were listed by the War Department as casualties in the Italian campaign during the month of July and Au-

gust, 1944.

27 Japs Jailed for Rebelling Against Draft Order at Tule Lake Center

Twenty-seven Japanese youths from the Tule Lake relocation center were lodged in jails at Alturas, Calif., and Klamath Falls, Ore., yesterday after they rebelled against registering for the draft under President Roosevelt's recent proclamation making them liable for military service.

The youths, all under 30, were taken into custody after they handed authorities at the center a statement claiming the registration for the draft at the center was "discriminatory" in that they had previously registered the same as other citizens. All twenty-seven are American born.

Harvey M. Coverley, director of the Tule Lake center, described the twenty-seven as "ill advised boys" who had been agitated by "a few subversive people." He said loyal evacuees on the project were "greatly disturbed" by the youths' action and feared it would jeopardize their opportunities to take advantage of the work clearance program.

Under the registration program, American citizens of Japanese ancestry between 17 and 35 are being registered for military service. All evacuees, 17 years old or more, are being registered for voluntary outside work or work in war industries.

Coverley said there was no disturbance in connection with removal of the youths to jail. There is no prison at the relocation center. The youths were being questioned yesterday by authorities from Tule Lake.

NISEI ENEMY GETS JAIL TERM

WALNUT GROVE—The courts, from the smallest to the highest, "must uphold the laws of our country," Justice of the Peace Milo E. Dye declared today as he sentenced Mrs. Wilma Insigne, alias "Kitty Ferguson," to ninety days in the Sacramento County jail for disturbing the peace of a returning Japanese American family.

It was the first jail sentence ordered for the threatening of Japanese Americans who now are being permitted to come back to the west coast from War Relocation Authority (WRA) centers.

Sixty days of the sentence was suspended provided that Mrs. Insigne leaves the county for one year after she serve thirty days.

The complaint was filed by Army Pvt. Yoshio Matsuoka, who spent ten months in a German prison camp and recently met his family at a Colorado relocation center. He stated that Mrs. Insigne threatened to have his father's home burned down if the family remained in Walnut Grove.
