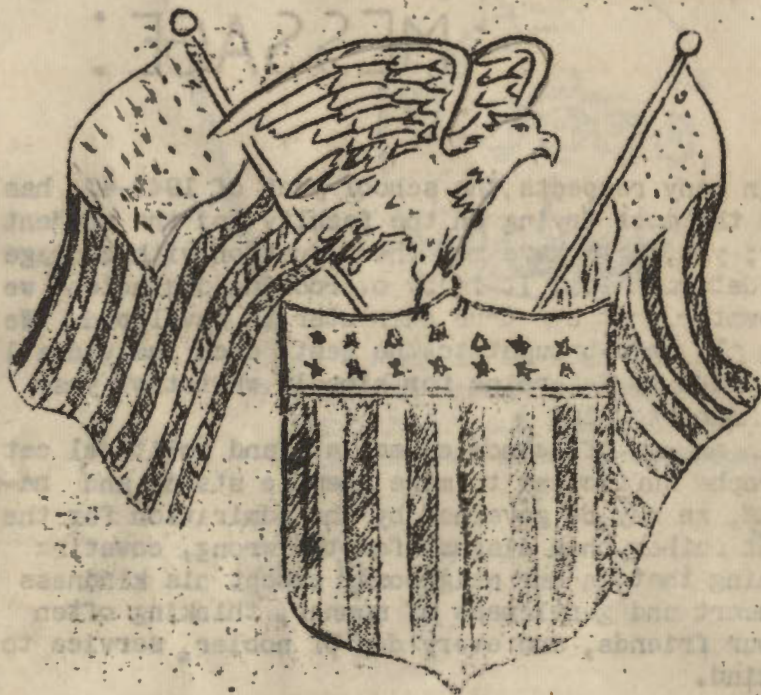
## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE:

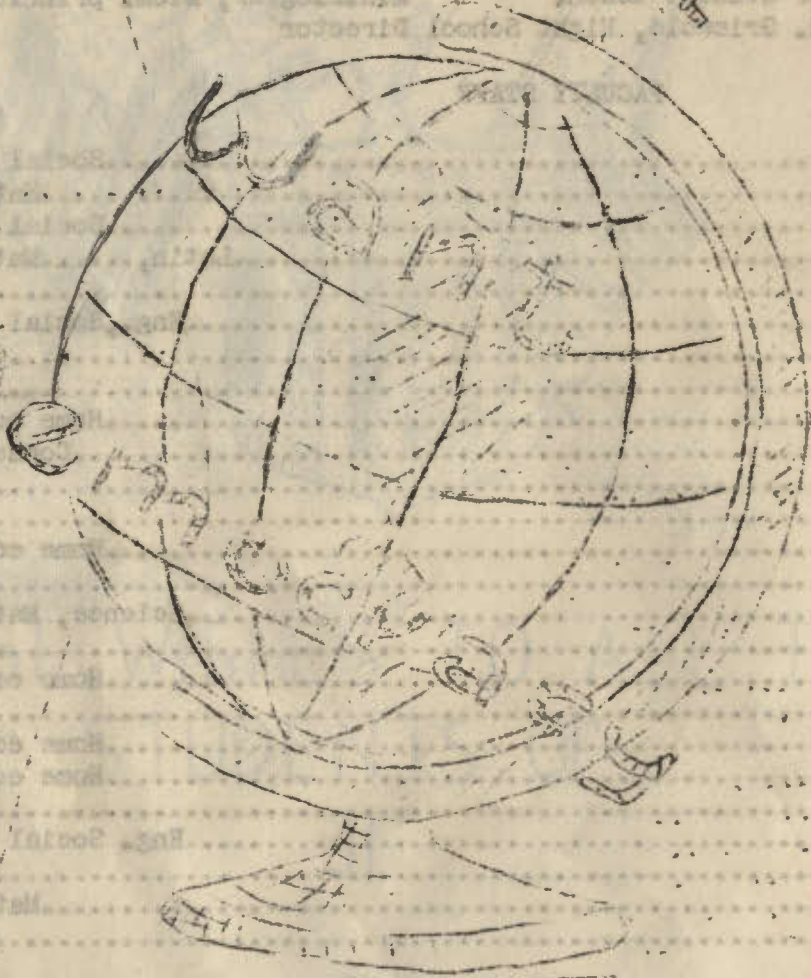

## N.M.A. Club

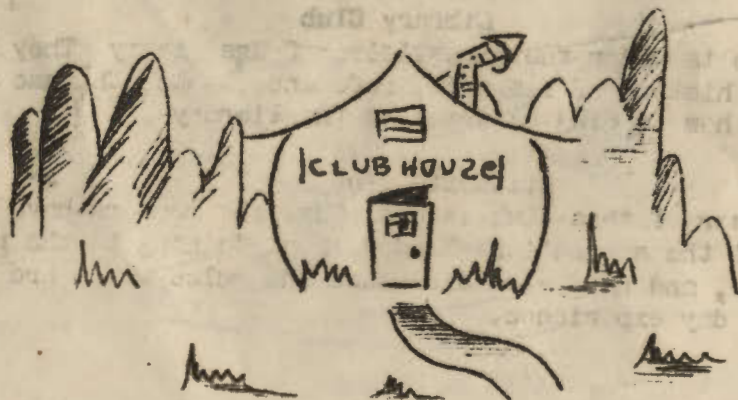

This club was recently disbanded because of the hot and humid weather. The club was composed of three industrious members. The advisor of this club was Mrs. Cook.

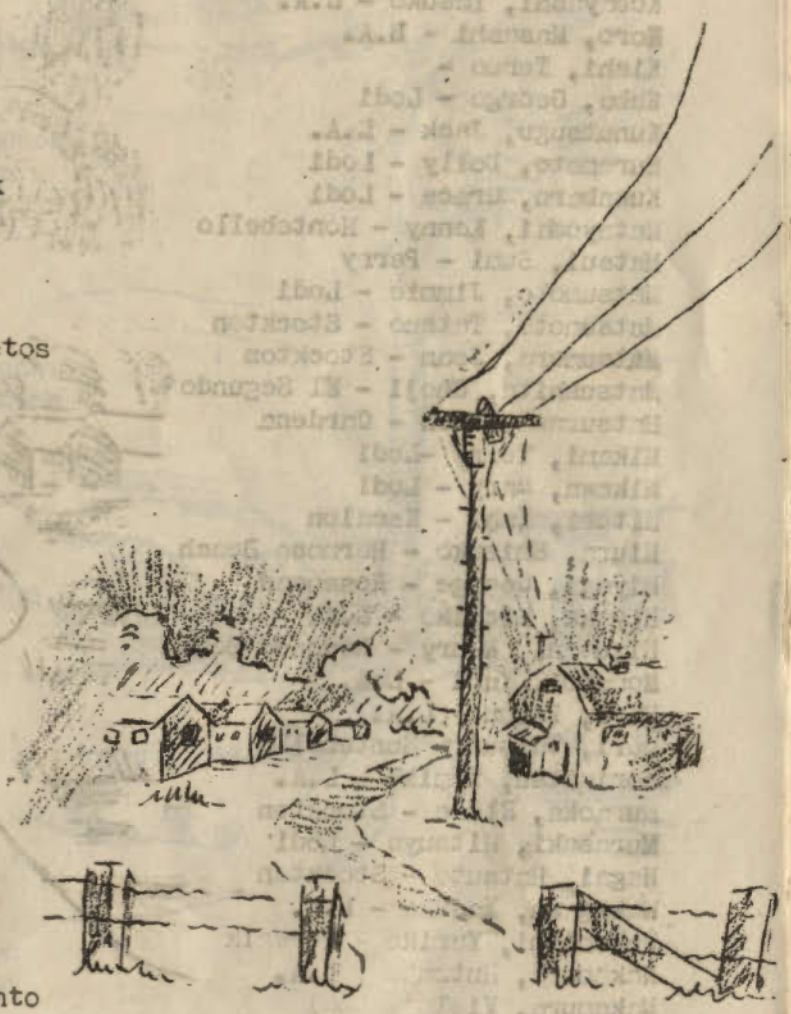
