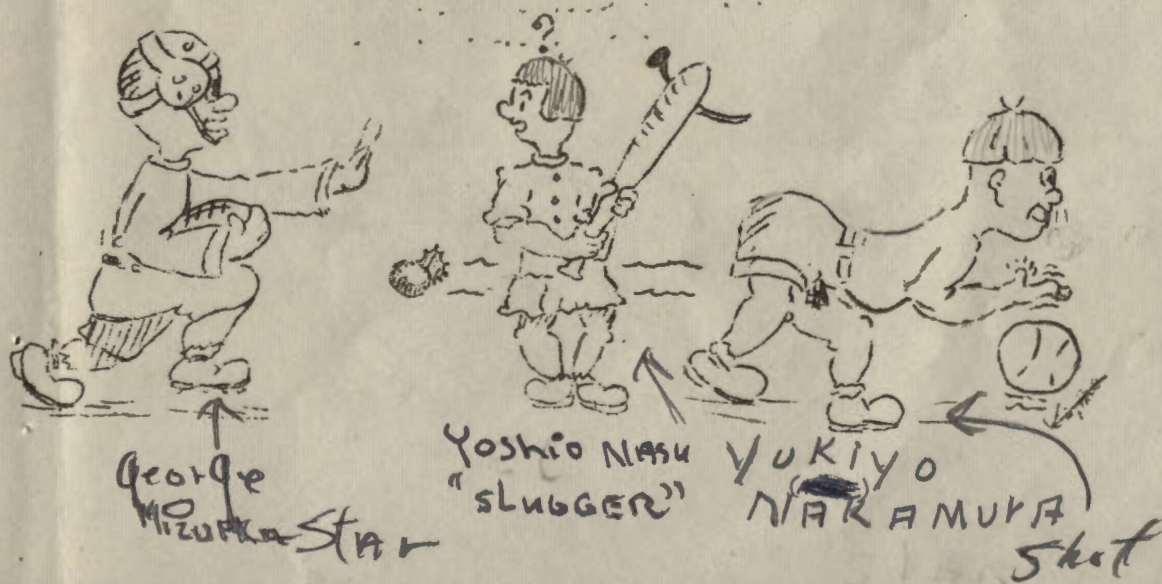
Intramural Volleyball Champion

BOYS' SPORTS

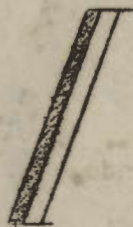
Boys' Intramural Sports Champs....
