Dear Recipient or Guardian:

The Office of Redress Administration (ORA) recently notified you that you (or the recipient you represent) have been identified as potentially eligible to receive compensation of \$20,000. In the letter, ORA requested that you complete a declaration and submit certain documents to verify your identity. We have reviewed the documents that you sent ORA, and found that some of the documentation is not complete. Until we receive all the proper documentation, ORA cannot confirm your identity for payment.

Attached to this letter is a checklist marked to show the categories and specific problems in the documents you sent us. You will also find attached any of your documents that were incomplete or not acceptable. To further assist you, we have noted on these documents what you must do to make them meet the requirements. If after reading through this package, you still are uncertain about what ORA will accept in your particular case, please call us on the ORA Help Line at (202) 653-8360 (VOICE) or (202) 786-5986 (TDD), Monday through Friday, 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., east coast time.

Please return the requested documents as soon as possible in order to avoid further delay in confirming your identity. Place the documents in the enclosed envelope and drop it in the mail. You do not need to put stamps on the envelope.

After ORA has completed the review of the documents you send back, and determined that your identity is confirmed, you will receive a letter stating that the review is complete.

As soon as funds are appropriated, we will notify you that you have been certified for payment. You will receive your payment in the form of a United States Treasury check for \$20,000 delivered by Federal Express.

You should know that submitting a false statement or fraudulent documents is a federal crime punishable by fine or imprisonment or both.

## **#2 A Document with Both Your Name and Address on It**

- A recent bank statement.
- A recent utility bill, such as electric, telephone, or cable television.
- A recent rent or mortgage payment receipt.
- A recent credit card bill.
- A statement from the administrator of the convalescent home where you reside.
- If you do not have any of these, you may send statements from at least two people who know your current address. These statements can be either notarized or contain authenticity clauses signed under penalty of perjury.

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V. EVIDENCE OF GUARDIANSHIP

--- You signed the declaration for the recipient, but did not send us proof of guardianship.

--- The address on the declaration does not match the address where the recipient resides. Proof of guardianship must be submitted if you write your own address on the declaration because you take care of the finances of your parent and wish the check to be mailed to your home.

--- Your letter of guardianship was not signed under penalty of perjury. Send us back the letter with the the following declaration written and signed by you.

"I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct." Executed on (date).
