
Dear Mr. Yoshimya:

Thank you for your message to President Reagan concerning H.R. 442/S. 1009, legislation which would implement the recommendations of the Commission on Wartime Relocation and Internment of Civilians by, among other things, disbursing a payment of \$20,000, tax-free, to each of the estimated 60,000 Japanese-American survivors of the World War II evacuation and internment program.

The President and his advisers appreciate having the benefit of your thoughts on this sensitive issue. It is important that the President be fully informed of all points of view on such an important matter, and your comments will be carefully considered if this legislation reaches the President's desk.
