

RECORD OF PEOPLE WHO LEFT THE JEROME R.C.

1. 708 persons to date as of June 30, 1943.
2. 19-25 years average age of Evacuees who left the Center.
3. Majority of them left for Illinois(Chicago) as unskilled labor. Approximately half as domestics.
4. 121 people went out on agricultural regions, mostly into Colorado, few into Michigan, Texas, Arizona and Montana.
5. Families who resettled in Colorado had friends or relatives who were already established.
6. 71 persons to date are out on seasonal leave. Leave being for 7 months at the longest.
