RECORD OF PEOPLE WHO LEFT THE JEROME R.C.

- 1. 708 persons to date as of June 30, 1943.
- 21 19-25 years average age of Evacuees who left the Center.
- 3. Majority of them left for Illinois(Chicago) as unskilled labor. Approximately half as domestics.
- 4. 121 people went out on agricultural regions, mostly into Colorado, few into Michigan, Texas, Arizona and Momtana.
- 5. Families who resettled in Colorado had friends or relatives who were already established.
- 6. 71 persons to date are out on seasonal leave. Leave being for 7 months at the longest.
