REFERENCE: Your Passport Application


The receipt is acknowledged of the supplemental affidavits for renunciants which were presented to the American Consular office at Fukuoka and forwarded to us by that office.

It is noted that several items are still lacking from your file, about which you were told in our memorandum to you dated January 10, 1950. The voting certificates which you submitted were not satisfactory. The one from Shippo-mura, Ama-gun, Aichi-ken should cover the entire period of your residence there.

There has now been another election, so that the certificate on voting from Kokura should be from August, 1946 to the present date.

Since such a long time has elapsed since your application, it is requested that you also submit a certificate showing your employment since the time of your visit to this office.

Until these items are received, no further action can be taken in your case.
