

By direction of the President and pursuant to authority contained in letter Headquarters NATQUSA, 16 May 1944, file AG 210.1/479-P, subject: Authority to Make Combat Appointments and Promotions in the AUS, you, having clearly demonstrated your fitness for commissioned grade through outstanding performance in actual combat, are hereby temporarily appointed a Second Lieutenant in the Army of the United States, effective ²²~~20~~ August 1944, with rank from that date. This appointment, unless sooner terminated, will terminate automatically at the expiration of the present emergency and six months thereafter. Your serial number is 0-1695640.
