Dear Mama:

Thank you very much for the eggs, meat, figs, nuts, et al. They certainly help out my food bill. I used the eggs to make custard with mostly, as that was the only way len and tom would eat them. Tom has been eating at my place for about the last three weeks.

His family has moved to stockton, and he has moved to Berkeley until school ends. After that he will probably go to some camp.

I am working for the Federal Reserve Bank in San Francisco. It pays more and my hours are much shorter than I could get by working in Berk. I leave home at 8:00 and get home at 4:45 which isnt bad. The train service is wonderful. I live only two blocks from a train stop so commuting isnt bad at all. I make \$116. I could only get 120 from the ordinary federal and the hours are terrible now, 6 day week, etc.

I expected you to come down this last weekend.

I stayed pretty close to home in case you did come down.

If you come down next weekend, be sure to phone me and tom & marg & len & me & you could have dinner out or ~~ingdithrix~~ at my place.

The federal still hasnt paid me 25 dollars they owe me (mcclellan field). Iwrote and they wrote and said they would send it week before last. nuts, they didnt I bought a blue dress to wear to work and 2 pairs of stockings this last Saturday. I really needed them. Inez is still in Mexico and will probably come home in May.

Len will go to the army may 11.

Marg came over for dinner last night.

Thanks for writing me a letter. Write me again.

Be sure to look me up when you come down this weekend and we'll all have dinner. I will be home most of the day. If I go out I'll leave a note by my doorbell.
