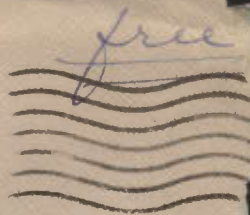
P.S. I was inducted Sept. 24 - went to Ft. Meade, then shipped here.
